**Become a part of Ascension's history and help build our new Memory Pathway by purchasing a memory brick today!**

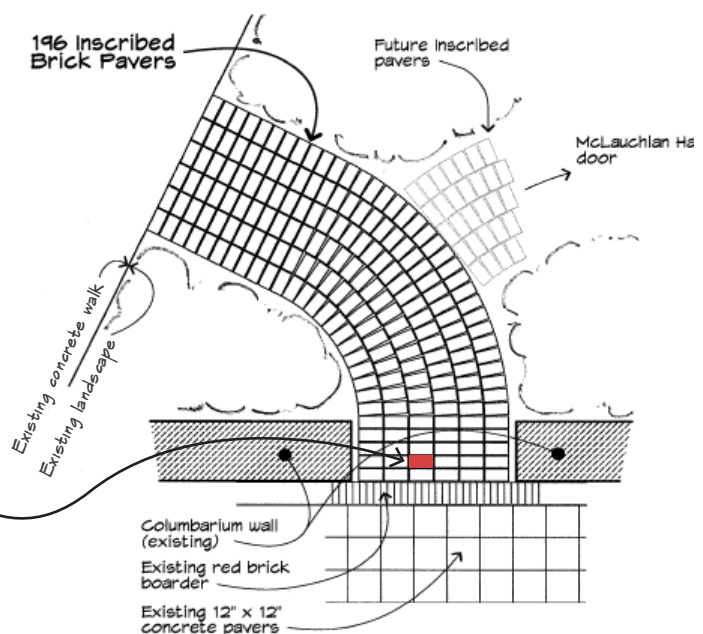
The Ascension Stewardship Committee is pleased to offer engraved dedication/recognition brick(s) as a way for us to share our stories, memories and further enhance our grounds! The bricks will create a pathway between the main entrance of the church and the Columbarium. Currently, there is a gravel path connecting these two spaces and it is uneven and overgrown with plantings making it hard to access.

You may choose to commemorate a memorable date like a wedding, confirmation or baptism. Perhaps you would like to engrave your name with a favorite scriptural phrase or line from a poem, or honor someone who has passed. Each brick will have space for up to 3 lines and you may choose to purchase more than one to complete your memory. The memory bricks are a special way to honor your children, grandchildren, parents, as well as to memorialize your loved ones, events, or beloved pets. This area will become an important part of our church history and a lasting tribute for loved ones and fond memories. We will have them engraved in phases – our goal for first phase will be at least 50 memory bricks and then 20 at a time.

Thank you in advance for being a part of the Ascension Memory Path brick campaign and helping to create a new area for us to share our personal stories and memories for generations to come!

Each memory brick is an engraved cement paver, 4-7/16” x 8-7/8” with a Red/Black blend color layer on top and charcoal black grout. Each can accommodate three lines of text. Text may be a maximum of 18 characters (including spaces) per line. All text will be centered and in all capital letters. A heart ♥ (use \*) or cross † (use +) emoji may be used. Please clearly write one character per box. Punctuation and spaces count as characters.
